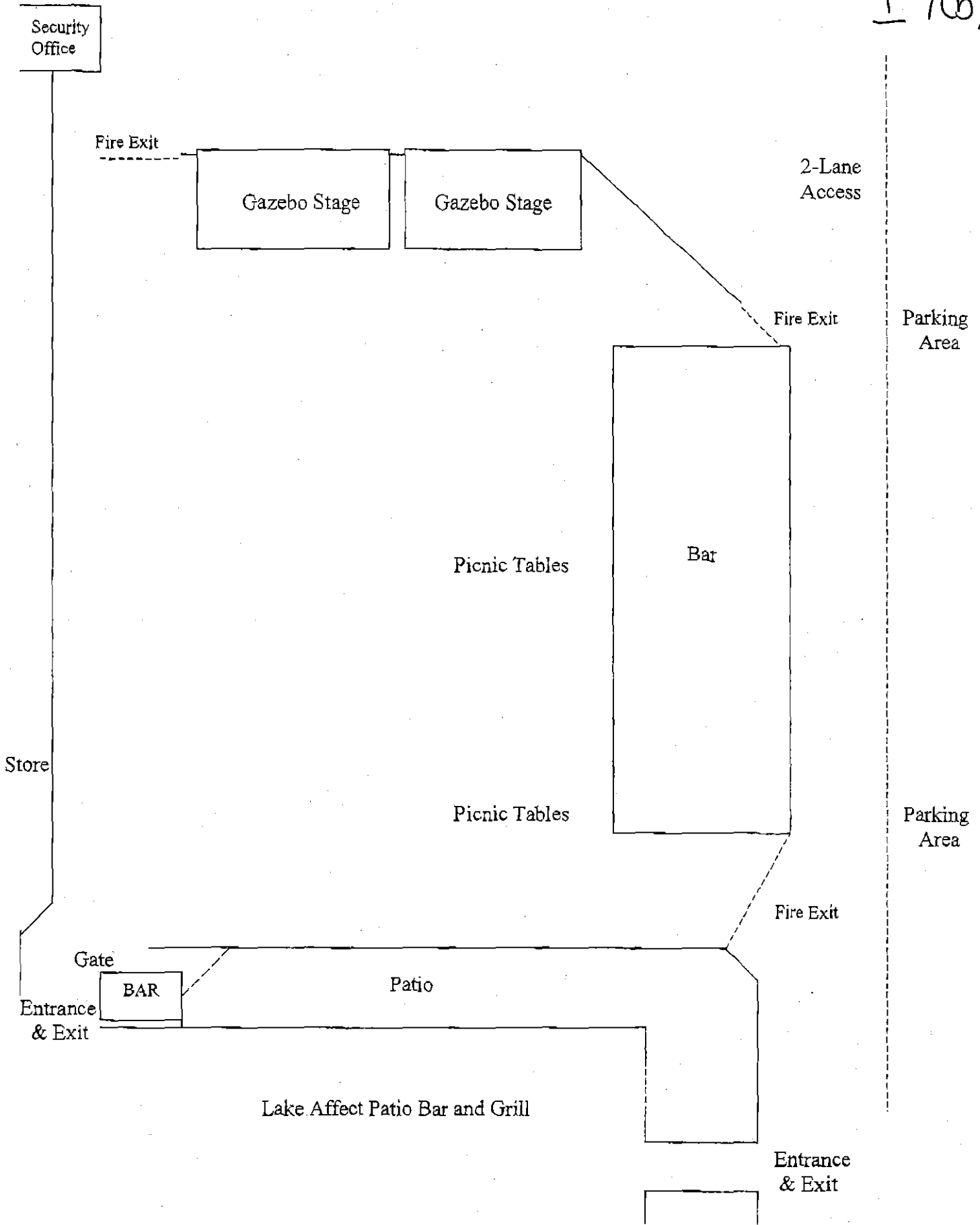

| <p>1) It is the responsibility of a licence holder with a Catering endorsement to notify the AGCO, Police, Local fire, health and building department at least ten (10) days in advance of the function, to advise the date, time, location and physical boundaries of the area where liquor will be sold and served, the estimate attendance, hours of operation, address of the event, the nature of the event and the name of the sponsoring person or organization.</p> <p>2) It is the responsibility of the holder of a catering endorsement to carry a copy of the liquor licence With the catering endorsement attached when transporting liquor to and from a catered event.</p> <p>3) Only liquor purchased under the licence can be Transported from the licensed establishment to the approved location for service and sale at that location.</p> | <p>4) It is the licence holder responsibility that liquor sold and served at the catered event is done so by the licensee or his/her employees and persons employed by the licensee must be trained in accordance with the regulations on server training.</p> <p>5) It is the licence holder's responsibility to ensure light meals are available at the catered event.</p> <p>6) As long as it is not a residence, the specified location for the catered event shall be deemed to be a licensed establishment during the time of the event and the licence holder shall ensure compliance With the applicable sections of the Act and Regulations.</p> |

Hi Carmela

Further to our conversation earlier today, GTA Midways Inc. has applied for the noise exemption with regards to the events in the parking lot at 1 Port St. E. for which Lake Affect is supplying the catering services. Sakina Hussain from Enforcement Division Research @ extension 4489 who is cc'd on this email has all of the updated information on the noise exemption request for GTA for the events if you require further clarification, please contact her directly.

I asked to speak to Ian Masini regarding our conversation and he is apparently on vacation. The acting supervisor for compliance and licensing is back tomorrow and I was told he would follow up with me when he returns.

As GTA is in the process of obtaining the noise exemption and that Lake Affect is only providing the catering services with no provision for entertainment or responsible for any noise being created from the GTA Event Stages, we believe that there should be no conflict with our current variance in effect from the Committee of Adjustments.

Centre City Capital which are the landlords and leaseholders for the property at 1 Port St. E. has authorized our use fo the space in the parking lot for the events and a letter to confirm their authorization will be forwarded to you first thing tomorrow as the authorized signator for the proerty was not available to sign the letter today but will return tomorrow.

Please let me know if there is anything else you require from us to ensure that there are no issues going forward with extension of the licensing of the area for the event and I will follow up with you directly.
