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This amendment is designed to extend the existing By Law to provide additional protection for the particularly large and mature trees that are so much a part of our neighborhood. We are modeling this amendment on the newly amended Tree Protection By Law for the Town Of Oakville (2008) which aims to protect and monitor the felling of these large, mature trees.

While some degree of tree removal is required to ensure safety in cases where trees are damaged or dead, the majority of trees removed in our neighborhood are healthy, mature. The ongoing removal of so many large trees threatens to irreplaceably change the local environment and destroy the unique character of our neighborhood. Healthy mature trees are often removed to make way for residential redevelopment and this By Law addendum would provide an opportunity for assessing the necessity of tree removal.

Current By Law for Mississauga states that property owners require a permit to remove 5 or more trees that are 15cm (6in) in diameter or larger from their private property in a calendar year. The amended proposal to the By Law would seek to require home owners and developers to submit an application for a tree removal permit in the following circumstance:

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

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

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

Proposed Amendments to the City of Mississauga Tree Permit By-Law

We the citizens of Mississauga support the proposed amendments to the Tree Permit By-Law 475-05 which include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Change the name of the existing by-law to 'Private Tree Protection By-Law' to better reflect its purpose and intent.
2. Require a permit for the removal of any healthy individual tree 30cm in diameter or greater.
3. Require a replacement tree for every 15 cm of tree diameter removed instead of the existing 'one for one' replacement guidelines.
4. Amend the fees to reduce the current \$320.00 fee to \$150.00 for the removal of 5 healthy trees between 15cm and 29cm in diameter in a calendar year; and the addition of a \$150.00 fee for the removal of any one healthy tree 30cm in diameter or greater.

2. I would have liked to have seen a few remarks re the #10 inter-change. It has some serious deficiencies worthy of comment. e.g. the so called drainage pond is a hazard. Should a car mount the guard rail & fall a 20' drop is hardly what I would call modern highway design. Not having a dividing island for the N & S service roads is unbelievable. You may also have noticed the Crestview S.B. road intersection is extremely difficult to maneuver safely as the sight lines are obscured.


To whom it may concern:

Unfortunately I have misplaced the notice of tonight's meeting and so I am unable to quote from it by other than memory. However you suggest that there should be a 5 tree limit on the number of trees, over a certain size, that can be cut down in the event of redevelopment of private property. Although this would not affect our property, notwithstanding that we have over 30 mature trees, we believe that there can be few absolutes in planning of this nature. Each case should be looked at based on its merits.

I can not be with you tonight because of a previous engagement. It is disconcerting to receive notice a few days before you plan to discuss such a suggested change and not have an opportunity to discuss it in open forum.

I am also very concerned about the municipality's plans to install a streetcar line from Brampton to Port Credit on Highway 10 without our having details of such plans and an opportunity to review them and to comment on them. There has been no effort made to inform us of the details involved. We live in an area that has become increasingly difficult to exit in an automobile. This could be a very serious barrier, particularly if the track right of way is to be elevated along any portion of the route as it is in Toronto on the St. Claire Line.
