# Alectra Utilities Corporation Underground Plant Relocation on Rathburn Road West from Station Gate Road to east of City Centre Drive

(Beginning as early as July 9th, 2018)

### What is the Hurontario Light Rail Transit Project?

The Hurontario LRT will be a 20-kilometre, 22-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal. The Hurontario LRT will connect with the Port Credit and Cooksville GO stations, Mississauga Transitway, MiWay and Züm transit lines.

## What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, Alectra Utilities Corporation is required to install new infrastructure along **Rathburn Road West** from **Station Gate Road** to the east side of **City Centre Drive**.

This infrastructure is the main artery servicing the businesses along Rathburn Road West and must be re-routed to ensure reliable service to customers.

### **Timing**

- Work will start as early as July 9th and will last for approximately 6 months.
- Construction work may take place up to 24 hours a day, 7 days a week between mid-July and late-August to accommodate construction around the MiWay terminal. Additional notice to follow.
- Upon completion of construction around the MiWay terminal, crews will operate between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday and some activity taking place on weekends and week nights.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.

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Note: at no time will all lanes be closed.

### What to Expect

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work

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### **Traffic Details**

- During construction hours:
  - Lane reductions will be required on Rathburn Road West between intersection of Station Gate Road to east of City Centre Drive.
  - o Lane reductions will be required on **Station Gate Road** (south bound) between intersection of Rathburn Road West & Centre View Drive.
  - o Lane reductions will be required on **Centre View Drive** north of Rathburn Road West & Centre View Drive intersection.
  - o Lane reductions will be required on **City Centre Drive** south of Rathburn Road West & City Centre Drive intersection.
- At a minimum, one lane in each direction will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- There will be no impact to property access.

### **Transit Details**

- To accommodate work taking place at the City Centre Transit Terminal, MiWay will be closing the terminal from mid-July mid-August.
  - o During this time, all bus stops will be relocated onto Rathburn Road.
  - o Pedestrian access through the terminal will be maintained.
  - o Access to the Terminal Building will be maintained at all times.
- Due to expected lane reductions delays are expected on all routes servicing the City Centre Transit Terminal.

### **Pedestrian Details**

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected. Please watch for signage directing pedestrian traffic.

### Dear Resident:

Robert B. Somerville Co. Limited, an Alectra Utilities contractor, will be undertaking the installation of hydro distribution system infrastructure from the west side of Station Gate Road to east of Centre View/City Centre Drive to accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT.



The work is scheduled to commence on July 9, 2018 and will take approximately 15 weeks to complete. This work will involve open excavation within the municipal right of way to install concrete encased ductbank, cable chambers and transformer foundations.

Construction is scheduled to begin at the intersection of Rathburn Road West and Hammerson Drive from July 9<sup>th</sup> - July 13<sup>th</sup>. Crews will then move to Rathburn and Station Gate Road from July 16<sup>th</sup> -August 7<sup>th</sup>. During this time The City Centre Transit Terminal (CCTT) Bus Loop will be closed for construction. MiWay services within the CCTT building will continue to be available. The north and south doors of the transit terminal will remain open, however; the east and west doors will be closed during construction until the terminal reopens on August 8th. Crews will continue with construction, moving east towards City Centre Drive/Centre View Drive. During this time there will be lane closures to accommodate the installation of the infrastructure. Appropriate approvals were granted by the City of Mississauga.

The expected working hours are scheduled to take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., along with 24 hour and Sunday work planned between July 16, 2018 to August 29, 2018. The night works will occur both along the front of the City Centre Transit Terminal and 3 crossings on Rathburn Road between Station Gate Road and Hammerson Drive. Please note that our work schedule is subject to change.
